DUBAI WORLD CUP INCENTIVES

1. TRAVEL

a. The Dubai Racing Club will provide air tickets to Dubai for the connections of overseas horses selected to participate in the Dubai World Cup, Dubai Turf, Dubai Sheema Classic, Dubai Golden Shaheen, UAE Derby, Godolphin Mile, Dubai Gold Cup, Al Quoz Sprint and Dubai Kahayla Classic.

Return business class tickets on a carrier designated by the Dubai Racing Club will be sent to the following connections:

- i. Registered Owner, up to 2 tickets.
- ii. Trainer, up to 2 tickets.
- iii. Jockey, one ticket.
- b. Only the above connections are eligible for travel concessions and the following restrictions apply:
 - i. In the event an owner has an interest in more than one runner, a maximum of two concessions will be granted one for the connection and one for his/her spouse/partner. No additional concessions will be reallocated.
 - ii. In the event any connection fulfils more than one role (i.e. owner/trainer), a maximum of two concessions will be granted - one for the connection and one for his/her spouse/partner. No additional concessions will be reallocated.
 - iii. Owners, trainers or jockeys currently residing in the UAE are not eligible for travel subsidies.
 - iv. In the event that trainers or jockeys have more than one horse participating at the DWC meeting, only one concession will be granted. No additional concessions will be reallocated.
 - v. In the event a syndicate or group of owners has more than one horse participating at the DWC meeting, a nominated owner per horse will receive a maximum of two concessions one for the owner and one for his/her spouse/partner.

No additional concessions will be reallocated.

Please note concessions are not transferable.

Connections wishing to stay at hotels other than the Official Hotel will have to cover the cost and associated expenses.

DUBAI WORLD CUP INCENTIVES

2. HOTEL ACCOMMODATION

- a. Hotel accommodation, room only basis, will be provided at the Official Hotel. One room for a maximum of two persons will be provided to each of the following connections:
 - i. Registered owner, 5 nights.
 - ii. Trainer, 5 nights.
 - iii. Jockey, 4 nights.
 - iv. Owner, trainers or jockeys residing in the UAE are not eligible for the hotel accommodation subsidies.
- b. Only the above accommodation concessions will be granted and the following restrictions apply:
 - i. Owners, trainers and jockeys wishing to be accommodated outside March 26-March 31, 2024 will cover the cost of any additional nights and associated expenses themselves.

3. TRANSPORT SERVICE

- a. Transport between the following locations will be arranged by the Dubai Racing Club for owners, trainers and jockeys:
 - i. The Dubai International Airport/ and the Official Hotel.
 - ii. Meydan Racecourse for morning track work and the Dubai World Cup race meeting
 - iii. The venues for official functions.

4. ASSISTANT TRAINERS, HEAD LADS, EXERCISE RIDERS AND GROOMS

1. TRAVEL

a. Trainers/Staff will not be permitted to accompany horses on the flights.

2. ACCOMMODATION

- a. Suitable modern accommodation will be provided either within the Quarantine Stables, which have a limited number of fully furnished rooms plus dining facilities or at a nearby hotel. Priority for accommodation at the Quarantine Stables will be given to grooms arriving early and then to non-English speaking persons.
- b. Breakfast and dinner will be provided for all staff at the Quarantine Stables.
- c. Staff accompanying horses already in Dubai for the 2024 Dubai Racing Carnival and subsequently invited to run at the Dubai World Cup meeting will remain in the accommodation supplied to them for the duration of the Dubai World Cup Carnival unless otherwise notified by DRC staff.
- d. DRC will cover costs for stable staff travel and accommodation based on 1 staff member per horse.

Note: Subsidies for horses invited to the Dubai World Cup meeting will commence Sunday, March 10, 2024.

3. TRANSPORT

a. A shuttle bus service will be provided to transport staff from the hotel to Meydan Racecourse.

DWC BONUS SCHEME



An exciting new Bonus Scheme of qualifying races for the Dubai World Cup has been announced, with more than \$4 million in additional prize money up for grabs.

Nine races, all run at Meydan Racecourse between January and March 2024, will give the winners automatic entry to the corresponding race on Dubai World Cup night, March 30th, with a chance of a 10% bonus if they win both races.

The bonus scheme is the first of its kind in the region and is aimed at encouraging trainers and owners to prepare their horses in Dubai for the Dubai World Cup, something which has already

proved successful. Thunder Snow, the only dual winner of the race, in 2018 and 2019, is the most recent DWC winner to prepare by competing at Meydan. This season, two races, the G1 Maktoum Challenge on January 26th, and the G2 Maktoum Classic, on March 2nd, both qualifying races for the G1 \$12million Dubai World Cup, offer \$1.2million in additional prize money.

SHIPPING CONDITIONS

All shipping arrangements will be co-ordinated through Janah Management Co Ltd or by their appointed shipping agents.

For the horses invited to run on Dubai World Cup night, the Dubai Racing Club (DRC) will pay or provide for:

- The following expenses for overseas horses, for the duration of their stay in Dubai, prior to and including the running of all races on the Dubai World Cup programme:
 - a) Feed, fodder, bedding, water and basic horse care products
 - b) Shoeing (non-therapeutic)
- All horses will share a pallet, where possible, providing each horse with a stall and a half.
- When tack and equipment cannot be accommodated on the pallet, all additional goods must fit into an LD3 container.

Any change from the transport arrangement suggested by the DRC which incurs additional cost will be at the owner's expense. The shipping arrangements of all horses will be organised by the DRC shipping agents.

The DRC and its transport agents will not be liable for any death of or injury to any invited horses during transportation to and from the United Arab Emirates or while in the United Arab Emirates.

Horses from the same region will, as far as possible, travel on the same flights.

The DRC will arrange and cover the normal costs of return transport by road from the home stable to departure airport, and return air transportation to country of origin based on existing cargo routes. However, any costs relating to a period spent in quarantine on return to their home country will be at the owner's expense.

The DRC will not be responsible for horse insurance.

Connections should have their own insurance arrangements.

POST ARRIVAL RECOVERY PERIOD

- Horses arriving in the UAE will be restricted to their allocated compound at the Quarantine facility for up to 48 hours, depending on the length of journey.
- Horses which travel for less than six (6) hours (stable to stable) will be confined for a minimum of 12 hours after their arrival at the quarantine facility.
- Horses travelling for more than six (6) hours (stable to stable) will be confined for a minimum of 48 hours after their arrival at the quarantine facility.

During this time, they will not be allowed out on the exercise track; they will be closely monitored for recovery from the journey and appropriate testing will be performed based on country of origin.

Exercise will be permitted within the confines of the facility with each compound having a walking ring. The rules are intended to reduce the risk of disease developing in horses and possibly spreading to other horses.

VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS

Equine influenza vaccination requirements for permanent entry into UAE is compulsory. Within 60 days of export but NOT within 14 days of export the horse must be administered the following:

- Either a valid primary course consisting of two vaccinations 21 42 days apart with the same vaccine (both doses must be administered within the 60 days but not within 14 days of travel.)
- Or a booster to a valid primary vaccination (21 42 days apart with the same vaccine)
 boosters must be given within 12 months of the primary course, and within
 12 months of each booster vaccination. The most recent booster must be within
 60 days but not within 14 days of shipping.

If the primary course in the passport does not meet with the required 21 - 42 day interval, or both doses were not the same vaccine then a new primary course MUST be given.

If there is more than 12 months between any booster doses a new primary course MUST be given.

If you are considering travelling your horse to the Dubai World Cup please urgently send a coloured scan of the passport vaccination pages to JMCL so that they can advise if there is any action to take in this regard to ensure shipping.

VETERINARY PROTOCOLS

VETERINARY INSPECTION OF HORSES COMPETING AT DUBAI WORLD CUP MEETING

- 1. Every horse invited to compete in the Dubai World Cup meeting will be subject to a Veterinary inspection performed by the Emirates Racing Authority Veterinary Officer. The purpose of the inspection is to ensure that a horse does not have any abnormalities which could adversely affect its health, its performance, or its chances of competing in its race at this meeting.
- 2. This compulsory inspection will be performed between two (2) days and five (5) days, prior to Dubai World Cup race day, or at any other time determined by the ERA and the Dubai Racing Club.
- 3. The inspection will require the horse to be identified via its passport and to be trotted-up in hand on a firm, flat non-slippery surface to assess its action and to have its locomotory structures palpated for abnormalities.
- 4. If a relevant abnormality is detected, the ERA Veterinary Officer will monitor the condition of the horse in consultation with an ERA appointed panel of Veterinary Surgeons
- 5. Trainers are invited to present horses which may have some gait idiosyncrasies to the Veterinary Officer earlier than the suggested dates to overcome any misunderstanding on suitability to race issues.
- 6. A video of the horse trotting at least 20m towards and away from the person recording the video, on a firm flat surface no longer than 6 days before departure for Dubai. Video to be sent to the ERA Regulatory Veterinarian
